Terms & Conditions

Entry Fee:

There is no entry fee for applicants and no admission fee for a guardian present.

Any extra persons are required to pay the standard Montsalvat entrance fees.

Shooting at Montsalvat:

Please note that there are some rules around entry and conduct of photography at Montsalvat.

Montsalvat is open to the public Thursday-Sunday 10am-4pm and you are welcome to come in to take photos at any time during this timeframe.

Access outside of these hours is not permitted.

Entrant Eligibility:

A young person aged 14 - 18 based in Victoria. You do not need to be a student in secondary school education.

About:

Montsalvat is a heritage listed, multi-purpose venue, sometimes hosting weddings, memorials, and other functions. These events can close certain areas down to public access. If you have a particular area you would like to take photographs in and would like to know if that space is open to the public at your requested time, please call our phone line on 9439 7712 and ask about your area and the date you're planning to come in on.


Please note that photography sessions with high-impact set-ups are not permitted without prior authorization and booking. Low-impact and 'floating' photography are permitted without a booking. If your photography session may impact the public, or you are unsure, please contact Montsalvat's Film and Photography Coordinator at filmandphotography@montsalvat.com.au to discuss your project.

Drones are strictly not permitted for use.

Wildlife:

Montsalvat has flora and fauna to be mindful of. We have geese, peacocks, chickens and other native animals who call Montsalvat home. Please be respectful of the wildlife while exploring the grounds and the gardens. We have volunteers who spend many hours looking after our gardens. Please do not trample or disrupt the garden beds. Strictly no dogs allowed.

File Submission Information:

File type = .jpg format

File Size = 2000 pixels on the longest side

Profile = Adobe RGB

File Name = Your name_image name_month and year of application.jpg
[example: John Smith_photo title_April2023.jpg]

There must be no borders on images.

Applicants must be able to provide high resolution .png files of their work for printing and display purposes should they be selected as winner.

A high-quality image printed at 20cm x 30cm will typically be 3MB - 6MB. If you are using a digital camera, make sure the quality setting is on high. If using a film camera, you will need to scan the image at high resolution. If using an iPhone, when uploading your image, make sure you transfer the photo at the highest quality.
